Team Role and Responsibilities

- The Home Units (HU) Team exercises and trains in point-to-point communications methodologies that are home-based (as opposed to field-based). During an emergency, Home Units Team members carry out their prescribed duties as required by EOC/FEMA management personnel.
- The HU Team operates in concert with the Hospitals Team during emergencies in which the sole means of wide-area communication will be radio-based. HU will support VHF-to-HF Hospital Team training and exercises.
- The HU Team manager, in consultation with other RACES team managers, plans HU support for all scheduled EOC/RACES exercises and actual incidents.
- The HU Team manager will ensure that periodic training in all aspects of HU Team operations is accomplished.









